

Wellington Financial LP provides \$3 million financing for DreamCatcher Inc.

Toronto, Ontario (June 16, 2005) – Wellington Financial Fund II (“Wellington”), a privately-held specialty finance firm, announced the closing of a \$3 million debenture financing for Toronto-based DreamCatcher Inc. (“DreamCatcher”).

DreamCatcher is one of Canada’s leading interactive entertainment publishers and distributors. DreamCatcher publishes games on multiple platforms, including PC, Playstation®2 computer entertainment system, GameCube®, and Xbox™. DreamCatcher has been recognized as the publisher of several #1 ranked entertainment and adventure games, according to NPD.

“Wellington is delighted to join existing investors VenGrowth Capital Partners and Lawrence & Co. in supporting the growth of one of Canada’s few large independent software publishing firms,” said Mark McQueen, President and Chief Executive Officer of Wellington Financial LP. “While the development teams get most of the publicity, firms such as DreamCatcher often work with developers at the earliest stage of the creative process.
